QUESTIONNAIRE FOR EXPERIENTIAL KNOWLEDGE IDENTIFICATION

The project have aimed to identify both the perception of cadets and young graduates regarding the mentorship value and impact, collecting their opinions about what designed platform SEAMENTORS should bring as services for embarked cadets.

The partners had applied the questionnaire approved addressed to the cadets or young officers and separately to the professionals/companies with mentorship experience or potential designed.

The survey has been distributed through SeaMentors's project partners within various social media applications including the website (www.seamentors.eu), LinkedIn, facebook, ADL platform (https://marplat.eu/course/view.php? id=50) and direct email notices. The survey had been submitted by applicants throughout a period of 6 months, until October 2023.
